STUDENTS' FEEDBACK SUMMARY (MARCH 2016)

The Institution obtains feedback from the students pertaining to teaching-learning and consisting of evaluation of the teacher in respect of subject content, delivery, regularity, use of ICT, communication etc.

It is seen that the students have pointed out a few areas where the institution in particular the teachers and tools used have scope for enhancement in quality. These are as follows:

1) Learning Outcomes:

The students are generally appreciative of the content of the curriculum since it is relevant to the professional requirements and the teachers are very supportive of student's difficulties being solved for which the teachers encourage students and there is optimal classroom interaction.

2) ICT Enabled Teaching:

Most of the teachers are seen to make good use of ICT in the teaching-learning process which has been of use to the students. A few students have requested the introduction of webinars to connect with international seminars.

3) Extension Activities:

The institution is giving opportunities to students to represent the college not only in co-curricular aspects but also for getting hands-on experience through legal aid camps and other outreach activities.

4) Assessment of students:

Majority of the students recognize that the system of the assessment followed by the teachers is fair since the answer scripts for internal tests are shown to the students along with the scores. Likewise, classroom presentations are transparent and delivered before the entire set of students.
