STUDENTS' FEEDBACK SUMMARY (MARCH 2017)

It is a practice of the institution to obtain feedback from the students pertaining to different aspects of teaching-learning and also consisting of evaluation of the teacher in respect of classroom teaching and assessment.

It was seen that the students have made mention of some areas where the institution is doing well and a few areas where there is scope for doing better

1) Remedial Teaching

The students who are in requirement of additional teaching for solving difficulties, in particular with respect to answering University Examination are satisfied with the efforts taken by the institution in this regard. A need was expressed by a very few students to provide assistance in spoken English and communication skills.

2) Internships:

The students expressed satisfaction with the manner in which the College is encouraging students to undergo the compulsory internship. In addition, some students felt that the institution could assist them by providing introductory letters to senior lawyers for the purpose of special case study.

3) Library Resources:

The practice of Library Orientation for students has been appreciated since they are comfortable with making searches for topics assigned by teachers for presentations. Students are also making optimal use of legal search engines and are appreciated of the existing book bank facility. A few students have requested to add to the number of systems for access to online resources.
