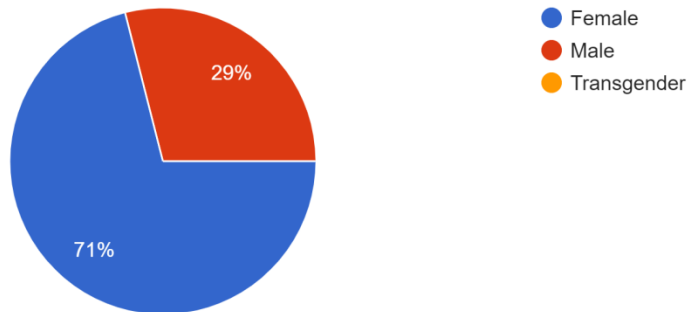

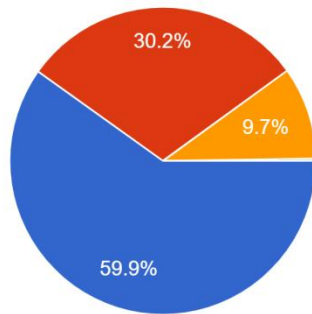

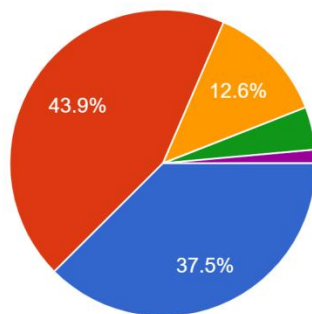

### How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

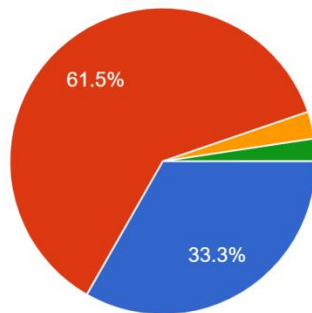

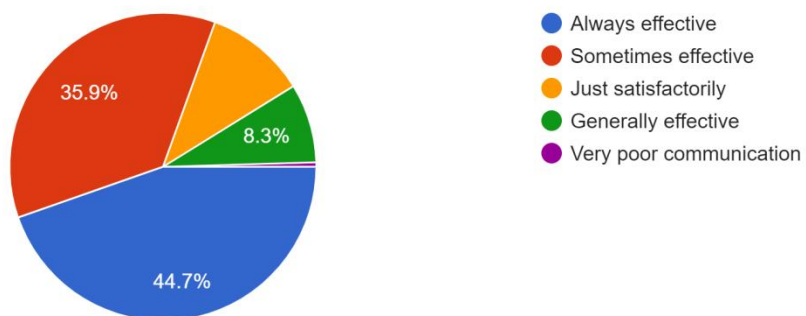

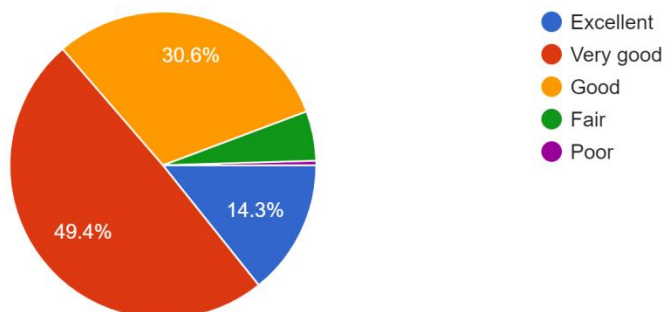
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

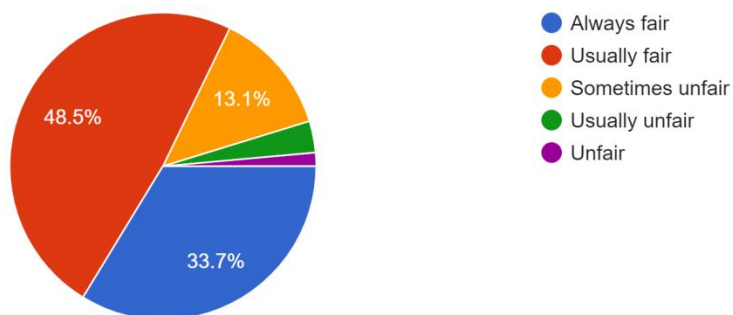
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

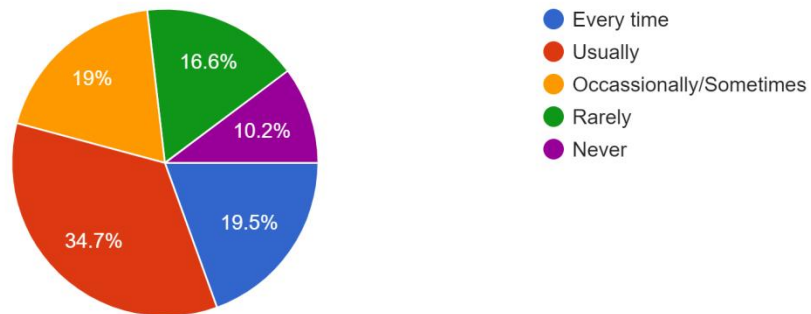
Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

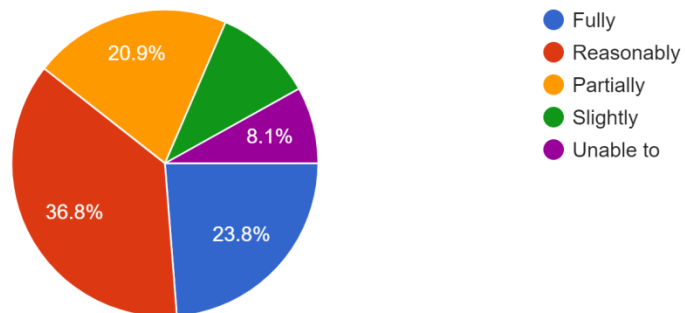

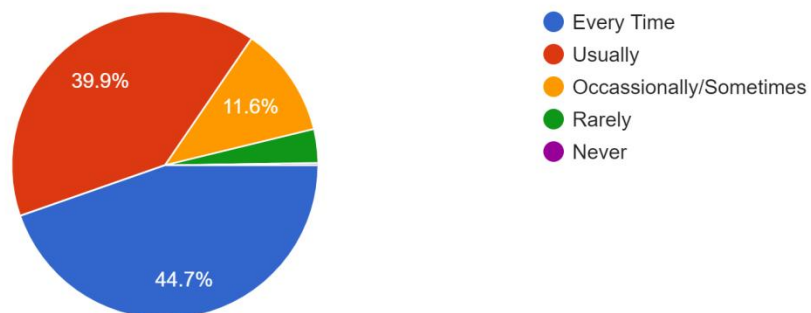

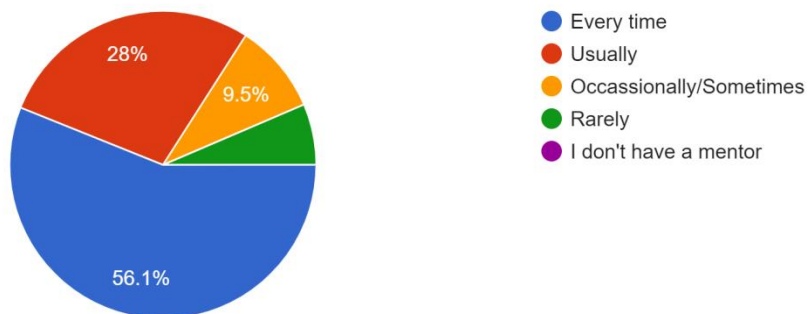

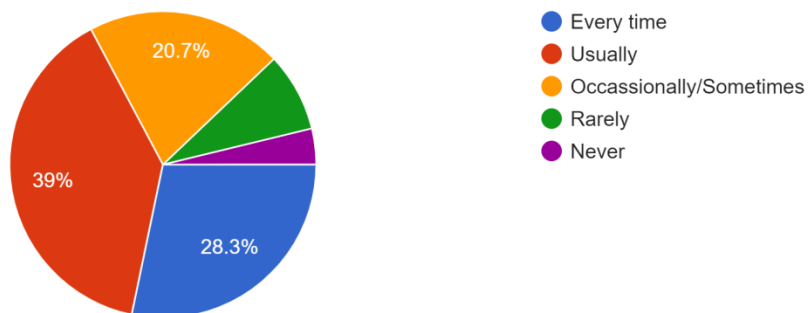

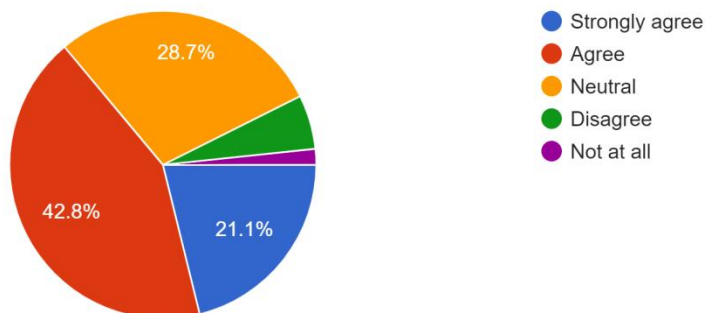

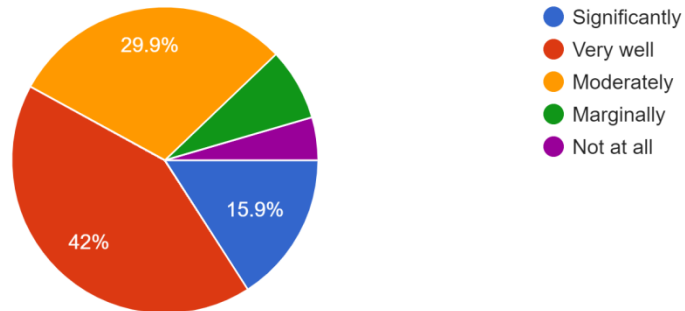

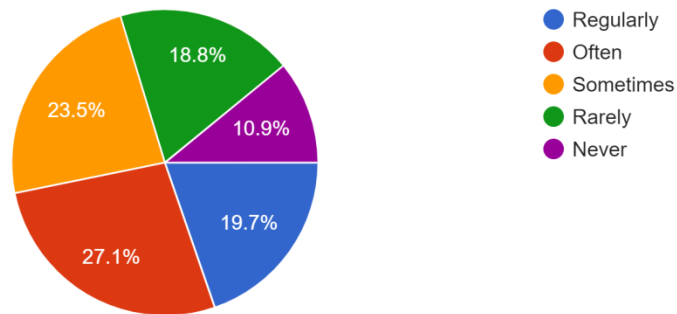

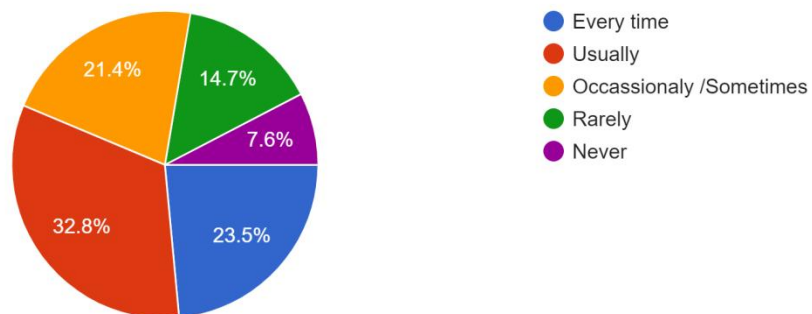

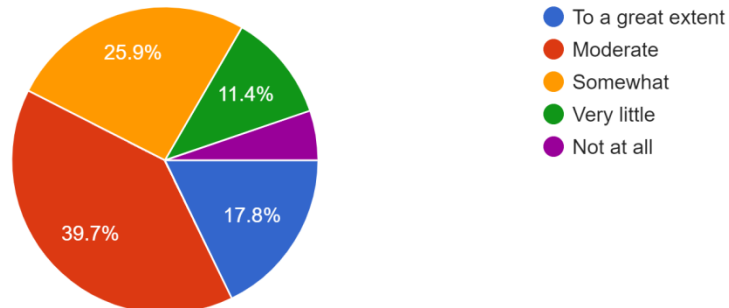
Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

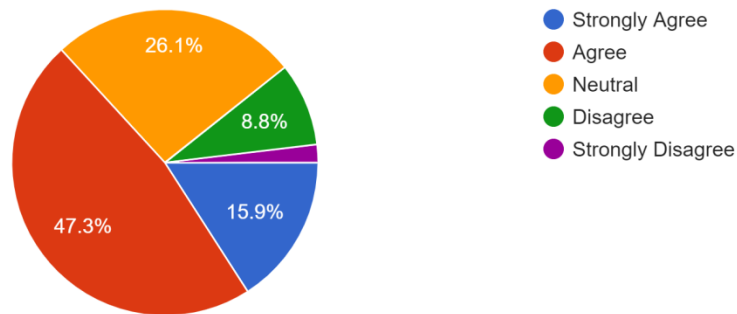

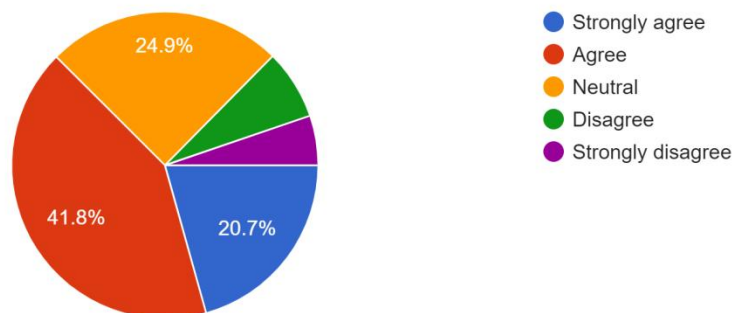

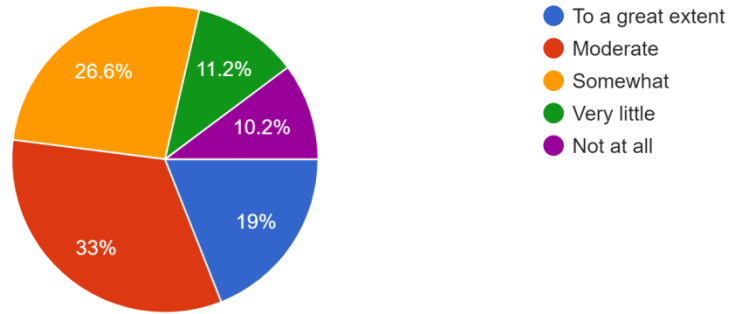
Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

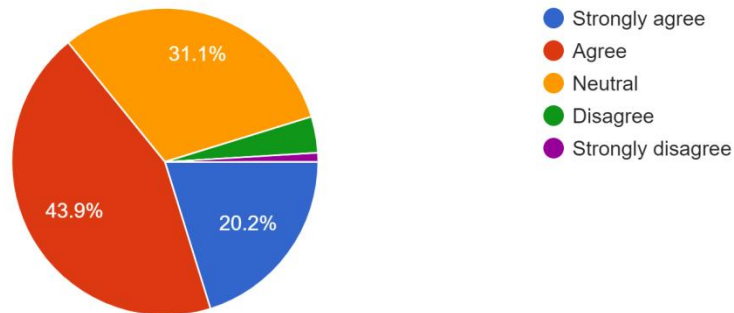

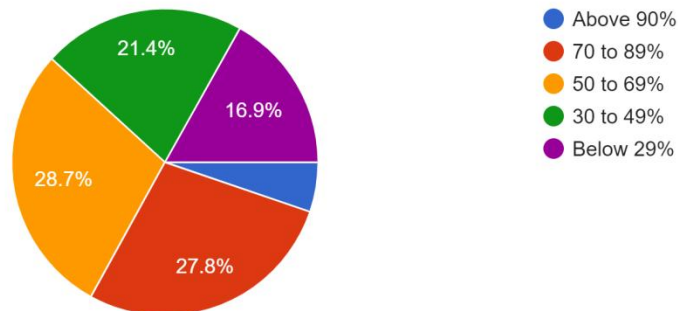
The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

## ANALYSIS REPORT OF THE STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS)

(APRIL 2020)

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is a mandatory criterion set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). The NAAC has endeavoured to conduct a Student Experience Survey, the results of which goes into the accreditation process. The Survey includes 20 competency-based questions, responses to which are given anonymously by students of the institution. This survey corresponds to an institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experience. The Institution this year had obtained the SSS through the online/ virtual mode wherein google forms were provided to the students during the month of March 2020. The process followed was a student friendly process which enabled them to become technologically oriented. The observations/outcome of this SSS has been mentioned as under:

1. Most of the students appreciated the teachers approach at teaching law subjects and thereby generating an interest of the subject among them..
2. Many students have agreed that teachers make use of practical illustrations and examples while teaching.
3. The institution makes efforts to ensure that the students are engaged in the monitoring review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process.
4. Effective mentoring encourages students to participate in many extra curricular activities like intra collegiate sports activities, elocution, debates, moot courts etc.
5. Students appreciated and accepted that efforts are made by the teachers of the Institution in inculcating social skills and increase the employability skills to make them future ready.
6. The students have lauded the guest lecturers in the nature of **GRK Masterclass** and **GRK talks**.

The SSS has brought to the attention of the institution some areas where there is scope enhancement in the quality of education. They are as follows:

1. Most of the students were of the opinion that the institution should in addition to academics also encourage their participation in various activities such as

elocution, debates, cultural co-cultural, extra curriculum including sports. The Department of Sports should be well equipped with the latest and modern equipments to enable them to compete at the University and National Level Sports competitions.

2. The administration should be imparted training at regular intervals in order to improve their efficiency.
3. The practicing lawyers/legal experts should be made an integral part of the system for the purpose of bridging the gap between theory and practice so as to be on par with the practical and theoretical learning.
