


















ANALYSIS OF THE STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS) 2021 – 2022

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is a mandatory criterion set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It is also a pre-qualifier for Assessment and Accreditation of the institution. From the year 2017, the NAAC has endeavored to carry out a Student Experience Survey, the results of which will go into the accreditation procedure. The Survey includes 20 competency-based questions, responses to which are given anonymously by students of the institution. This survey corresponds to an institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experience.

The College put into operation the SSS by administering a feedback form to the students and the observations/outcome of this SSS is as following:

- 1. Most of the students have said that teachers complete the syllabus on timely basis and preparation of the teachers is also up to mark, with effective communication.
- 2. Majority of the students appreciated the approach of the teachers and fairness in the internal evaluation.
- 3. A large number of students have said that teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and encourage them to excel in their academics.
- 4. Most of the students are satisfied with the efforts put in by the mentors of the class in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
- 5. Majority of the students have applauded the variety of teaching methods inculcated by teachers like use of LCD projectors, experiential learning etc, in the teaching learning process.

The SSS has brought to the notice of the institution some areas where there is possibility of improvement in the quality of education. They are as follows:

- 1. Students suggested more actions by the institution in the field of internship, placements, skill development and guidance for the preparation of competitive exams.
- 2. There is a need to impart more practical training to the students to make them future ready
- 3. In addition, students are to be encouraged to partake in extra-curricular activities
