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## TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

All the teachers are of the view that the content of the course/ coverage of the syllabus for the Law programme is a combination of modern and advanced topics and it also emphasizes on the understanding of the basics of the course

Majority of the teachers feel that the syllabus, its content and delivery have been applicable, for further studies and progression of career. It has also helped them for entrepreneurship and placement opportunities and also sensitizes them about the community and social needs

Majority of the teachers feel that the organization of courses in the programmes in the semester system is well organized in each semester and there is clarity in the same, while a few feel that the courses need to be revised.

As regards the interaction level in the class with respect to the courses, majority of the teachers feel that the courses give ample opportunities for class interaction between teacher and students. A few feel that the courses are more theoretical in nature and does not leave any scope for class interaction.

Majority of the teachers are of the opinion that the practical component in the syllabus for all the programmes needs a reconsideration and a few are unable to give their opinion on the same. But a few teachers are satisfied with the content of the practical component.

Most of the teachers feel that the theory courses in the curriculum require a re-examination while a few from the rest are fine with it and the rest cannot say anything about it.

Majority of the teachers are of the view that more specialization/ optional courses/CBCS courses are required to be added in the curriculum while a few feel that it is not required and the rest cannot say anything about it.

All the teachers are of the opinion that the experiential learning of the students through visits to jail, government offices, internship, projects, extension through legal aid etc. supplement the curriculum enrichment and its transmission.

More than ninety percent of the teachers are of the opinion that involving the alumni as external subject experts lead to enhancement of effective delivery of curriculum, while a few feel are not sure about it.

Majorityt of the teachers are of the view that the distribution of courses in the respective semesters is even and well balanced while a few do not agree with the same and a few chose not to comment on the same.

All the teachers are of the view that add-on/certificate programmes offered at the institution are helpful in curriculum advancement and development.

Majority of the teachers are of the opinion that the courses are suitable and practicable for professional practice in courts.

Majority of the teachers feel that the educational environment at the institution is excellent, while the rest feel that its very good.

As regards the adequacy of the content of the courses and structure of the curriculum and requirements of NEP, some teachers opined that the courses should have more practical approach with focus on internship. They also felt that there is a need to revise the curriculum and if possible to add Goa specific laws. Many of them are of the view that the syllabus is in tune with NEP. They also opined that the practical component in the syllabus should be also given more preference.
