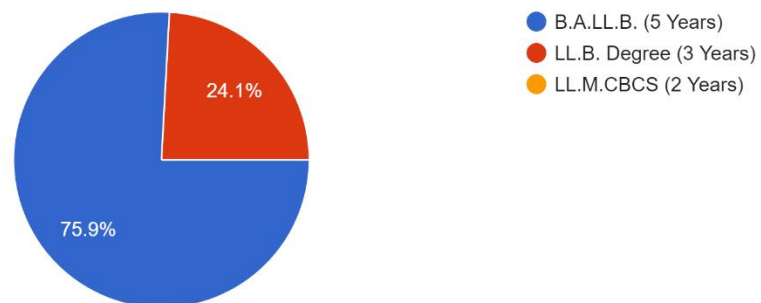

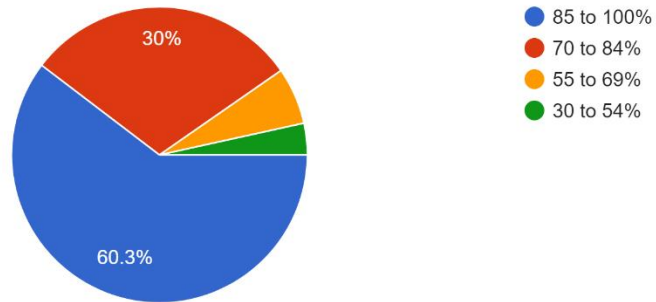

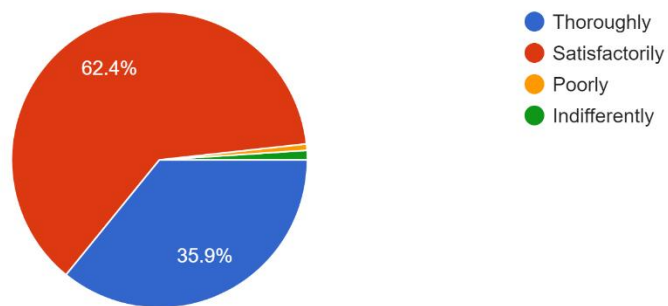
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

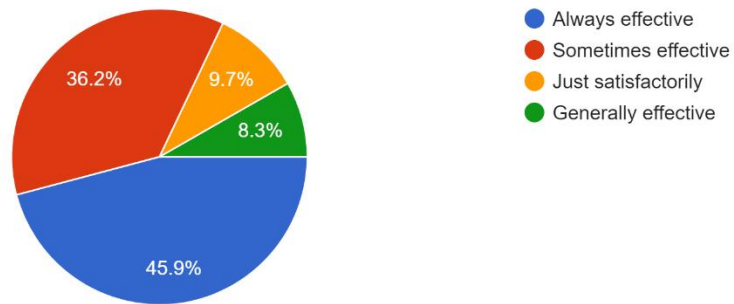
How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

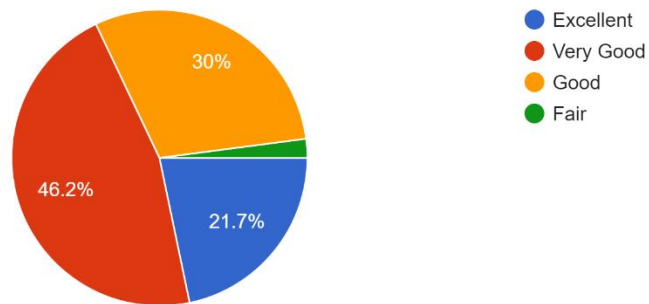
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

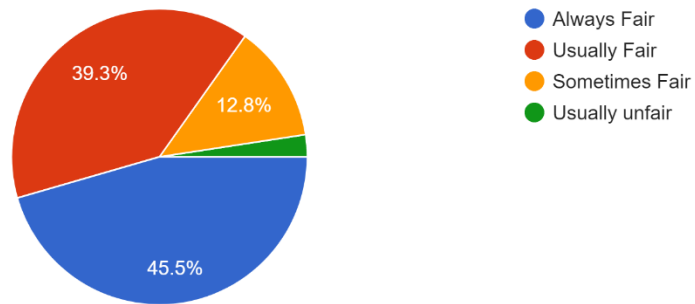
The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as

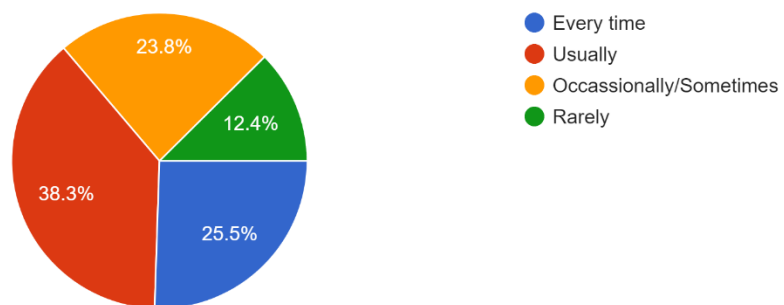

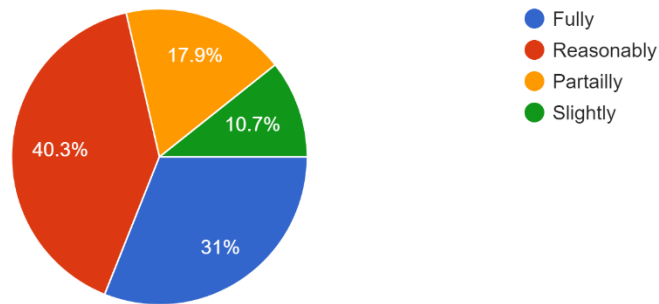

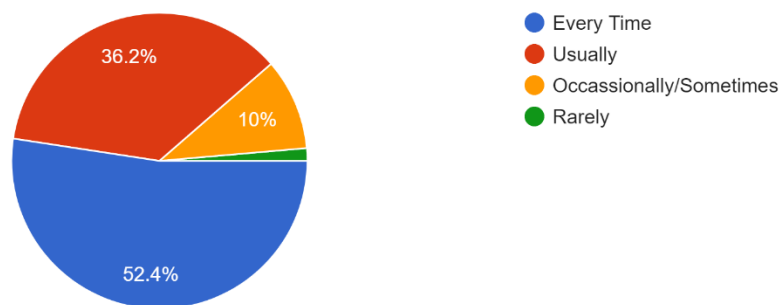

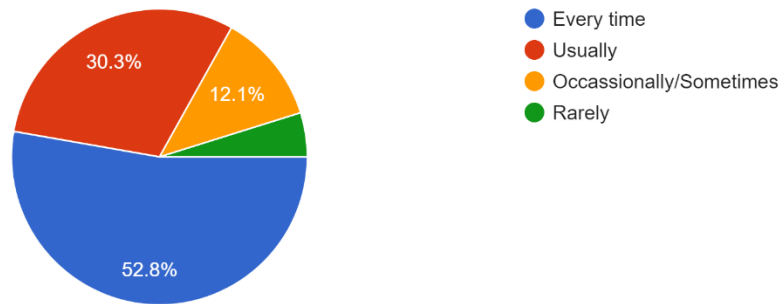

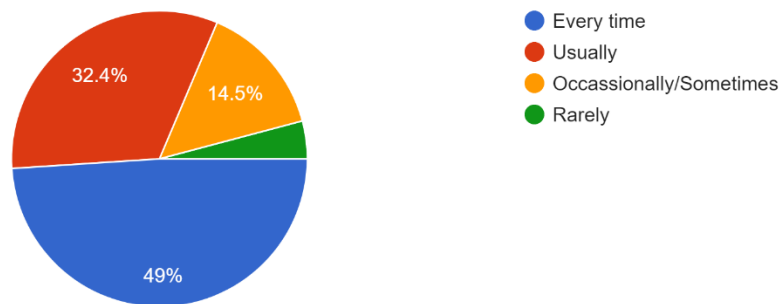

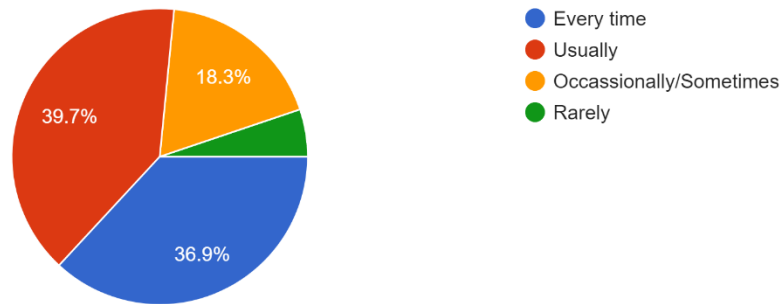

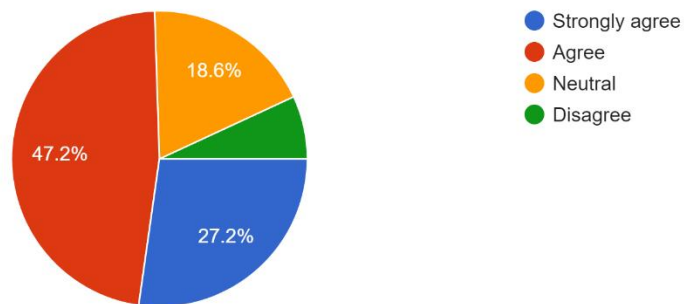

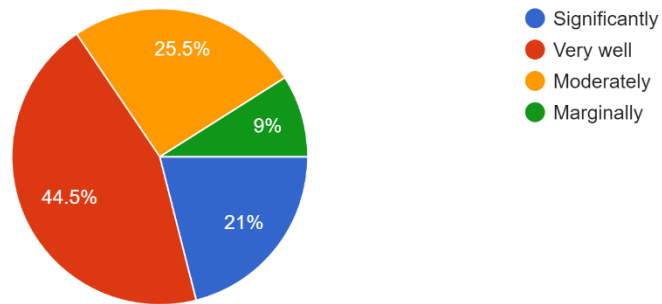

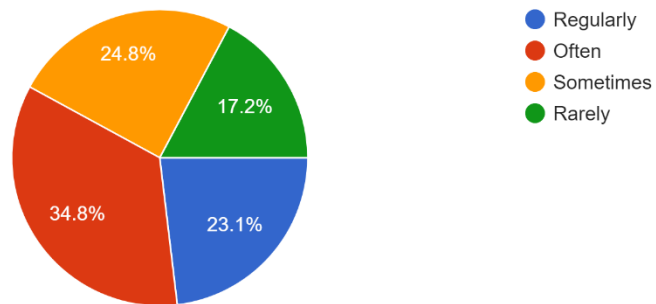

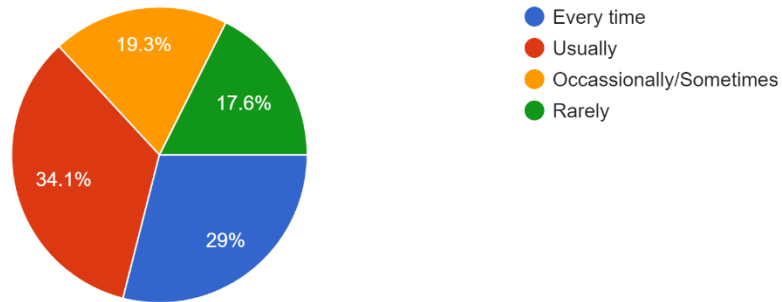

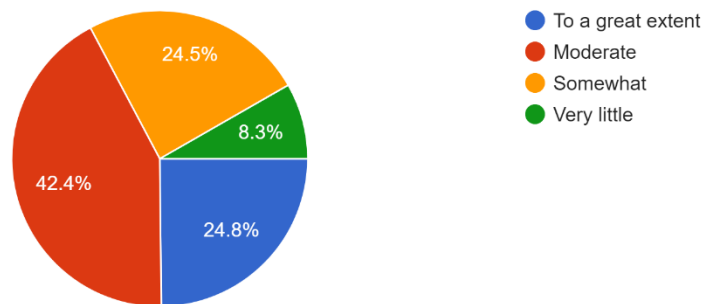

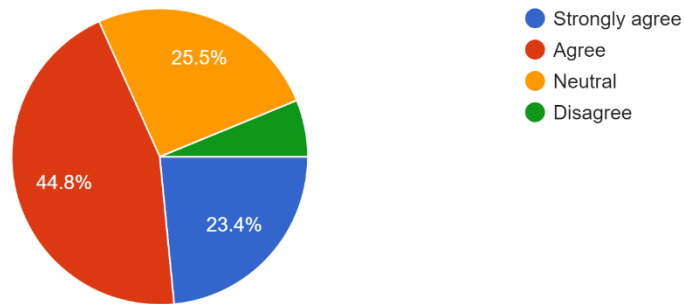

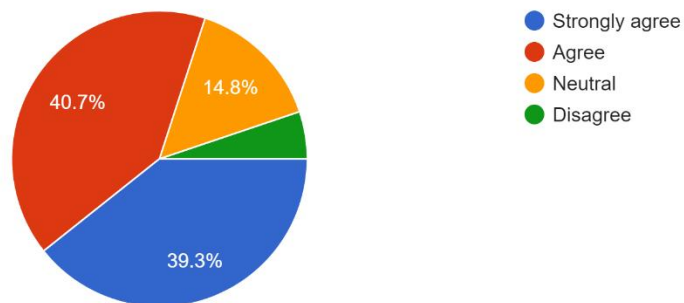

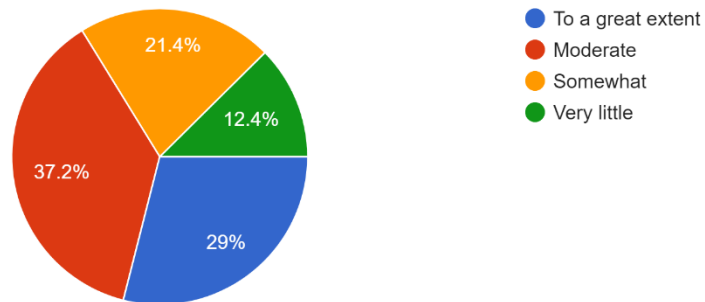

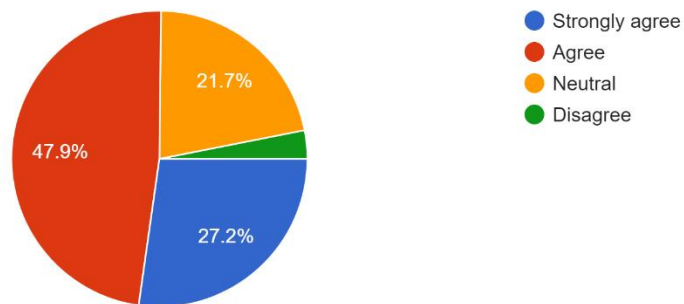

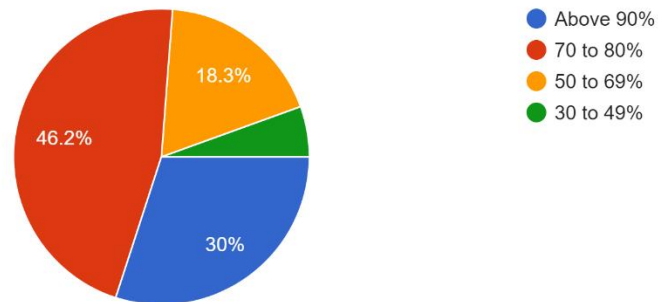


The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

ANALYSIS OF THE STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS) 2022 – 2023

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is a compulsory criterion set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It is also a pre-qualifier for Assessment and Accreditation of the institution. From the year 2017, the NAAC has endeavoured to conduct a Student Experience Survey, the results of which will go into the accreditation process. The Survey includes 20 competency-based questions, responses to which are given anonymously by students of the institution. This survey corresponds to institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experience.

The College implemented the SSS by administering a feedback form to the students and the observations/outcome of this SSS is as under:

1. Maximum number of the students were content with the ICT enabled teaching approaches adopted by the teachers.
2. Students valued the efforts of their respective mentors and college counsellor for successfully guiding them during the pandemic time.
3. Most of the students were of the view that the teachers were effective enough to deliver their classes and precision of communication was concerned.

4. Most of the students were pleased with the online library facilities provided by the institution and the role Department of Information and Library Science in the transmission of knowledge.

5. Students also found the process of internal assessment to be effective.

The SSS has brought to the attention of the institution some areas where there is scope enhancement in the quality of education. They are as follows:

1. Students recommended more endeavours by the institution in the field of internship, placements, skill development and guidance for the training of competitive exams.

2. There is a need to convey more practical training to the students to make them future ready

3. In addition, students are to be stimulated to participate in extra-curricular activities.
