As seats are still available, the University has decided to invite applications and conduct the Round II of GU-ART 2025-26, for the respective Programmes.

Round-II is announced in Programme where seats are vacant or lower number of candidates are available in the Merit List.

Candidates who have already answered GU-ART 2025-26 Round I for a particular Programme, are not required to apply again.

A. <u>GU-ART Coverage:</u>

- Admission to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be based on GU-ART. For details of Programmes offered at the University Schools and Affiliated Colleges, refer <u>Annexure I</u> and <u>Annexure II</u> respectively.
- 2. For details of fees applicable for Post-Graduate Programmes offered at the Goa University Campus for the Academic year 2025-26 refer Annexure III

Eligibility:

Admissions to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be entirely based on the **Goa University** - **Admissions Ranking Test (GU-ART)**. The marks/percentage obtained by the candidate while graduating would only be used to ascertain the eligibility of candidates for the Programme. The purpose of the GU-ART is only to rank the prospective candidates and not for determination of pass/fail.

Candidates who are in their Final Year of Graduation are also eligible to apply.

Selected candidates who are in the Final Year of Graduation shall be granted Provisional Admission. Their admission shall be confirmed after the UG results are declared based on the eligibility. In case a candidate fails to clear the Graduation Examination, the admission shall stand canceled and the fees shall be refunded.

For admission to the Programmes offered both at Goa University School as well as the affiliated colleges or at multiple colleges, seats shall be allotted through PHYSICAL COUNSELLING which shall be held at Goa University Campus. The candidates must attend the Counselling to be eligible for allotment of seats. No seats shall be allotted to the candidates who remain absent during the time of Counselling, for such Programmes. The dates of Physical Counselling shall be Announced on the Goa University website.


The Change of Discipline Test shall NOT be conducted for Round II.

B. Filling up of the Online Application Form:

Admissions Portal Link: https://unigoaadmission.samarth.edu.in

- a) The **LAST DATE** for submission of applications is **6th June 2025**.
- b) Candidates are advised in their own interest to apply online much before the closing date and not wait till the last date for applying/payment of application fee to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability/ failure to log on to the website on account of heavy load on the website.
- c) Goa University does not assume any responsibility to candidates in case they are unable to submit their application by the last date on account of the aforesaid reasons or for any other reason beyond the control of the University.
- d) The softcopy of the Passport size photograph and Signature provided by the candidate has to be according to the specification mentioned below:
 - i. Digital Photo and Signature are required in .jpg or .jpeg image format.

- ii. File size of digital photo must be within 10kb to 500 KB limit.
- iii. The face must take up 70-80% of the photo.

- iv. The same photograph and signature shall be used to issue Admit Cards for GU-ART, for issuance of University ID card and Examination Registration Process.
- v. Candidates shall not upload Selfies or photos of passport size photograph.
- vi. Student should mandatorily have the following documents in specified format to complete the online application. (Note: The documents to be uploaded should be in pdf / JPEG / JPG / format with file size 10KB-500KB)
 - o SSC Marksheet, HSSC Marksheet, UG Marksheet, PG Marksheet. (PDF format)

 - Recent Passport Size Colored Photograph (JPEG / JPG)

e) Printout of the application form is **NOT REQUIRED** to be submitted to the University.

Application Fees (Non-refundable) (To be paid online through Samarth portal only):

- INR 750 in case candidates belonging to Un-reserved/ EWS/OBC(NCL) for first application per subject/specialization, and INR 600 in case of every subsequent application in subject/specialization.
- INR 375 in case of Candidates belonging to SC/ST category from Goa per subject/specialization, and INR 300 in case of every subsequent application in subject/specialization.
- No fees shall be charged from Persons with Disability.

C. GU-ART:

Candidates are requested to note the following details regarding the GU-ART:

- 1. Candidates shall be permitted to apply for a maximum of three subjects/specializations for the PG Programmes.
- 2. Candidates who wish to apply for more than one Programme for Round II are required to use the same login details.
- 3. No changes shall be entertained after the application is submitted online.
- 4. The GU-ART shall be of One Paper of 100 marks, containing 50 objective Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) of 2 marks each. There shall be negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer. No marks shall be deducted for unanswered questions. The duration of the GU-ART shall be 90 minutes.

^{*}Candidates applying for admission under these categories shall be required to submit a valid Certificate to that effect issued by the Officer of the rank of the Deputy Collector or any other authorized Officer as notified by the Government of Goa.

5. The breakup of 100 marks for the GU-ART Question Paper shall be as follows:

a. Section I (Least difficult) - 15 Questions
 b. Section II (Difficult) - 15 Questions
 c. Section III (Most difficult) - 20 Questions

- 6. Details of Admission Test for M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence Programmes
 - **a.** The admission test **for M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence** shall be based on the syllabus notified by Goa University which consists of Analytical Ability and Logical Reasoning, Mathematics and Computer Science.
 - **b.** The GU-ART shall be of One Paper of 100 marks, containing 50 objective Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) of 2 marks each. There shall be negative marking, where half a mark shall be deducted for each wrong answer. No marks shall be deducted for unanswered questions. The duration of the GU-ART shall be 90 minutes

The breakup shall be as follows:

a. Section I – Analytical Ability and Logical Reasoning
 b. Section II – Mathematics
 c. Section III – Computer Science
 - 15 Questions
 - 25 Questions

- **c.** For M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence, Ranking list shall be generated based on the performance in the GU-ART. There shall not be any cut off percent.
- 7. In case candidates who have answered the GU-ART and have secured equal marks in the ranking list:
 - a. Section III scores shall be the first level of tie breaker, followed by Section II
 - b. In case the tie still exists, the University shall decide the order of merit.
- 8. A common GU-ART shall be conducted for admission to MA Wellness Counselling and Post Graduate diploma in Guidance counselling.
- 9. Candidates who have already applied in Round-I of GU-ART 2025-26, can use the same login account to apply for additional Programmes.

- **E.** A Common GU-ART shall be conducted for admission to MA Wellness Counselling and Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance Counselling
- **F.** Candidates answering the GU-ART Round II shall be ranked after the candidates who has answered previous Round. Example: If 100 candidates apply for Round I, all 100 shall be assigned a rank based on the marks scored. For Round II, candidates shall be ranked from 101 onwards. The candidate scoring highest marks at GU-ART Round II shall be ranked 101.

G. GU-ART Schedule:

The GU-ART Round II shall be held on 12th June 2025 and 13th June 2025. The Test Schedule shall be announced later.

The Test shall be held in ONLINE MODE.

H. Admission Process:

- 1. The results of **GU-ART Round I** shall be displayed on the Goa University Website.
 - a. For Programmes offered only at the University Schools or at a single affiliated College, the seats shall be allotted to candidates based on their performance in the GU-ART. Rules/Guidelines for allotment of seats are given in Annexure V.

- b. For Programmes offered at both the University as well as the affiliated colleges or at multiple colleges, seats shall be allotted through PHYSICAL COUNSELLING which shall be held at the Goa University Campus (click here to refer List of Programmes).
- **2.** All Candidates including those who are Selected/Allotted/Offered seats at the Goa University Schools or Affiliated Colleges shall be required to pay the Seat Confirmation Fee of Rs.10,000/- in online mode on the Samarth Portal.
- **3.** Reserved Category Seats remaining vacant after the 1st Provisional List of Round-I of GU-ART are transferred to the Un-reserved Category.
- 4. PHYSICAL COUNSELLING dates shall be notified on Goa University Website.

The Institution selected at the time of filling the Samarth Registration form shall not be considered as final preference. The institute shall be allotted as per the availability of seats in the concerned institute at the time of Physical Counselling. The candidates must attend the counselling to be eligible for allotment of seats. No seats shall be allotted to the candidates who remain absent during the time of Counselling.

Other University candidates are not required to be present at the Physical Counselling.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO PG PROGRAMMES

A] Shenoi Goembab School of Languages & Literature:

Master of Arts English, French, Hindi, Konkani, Marathi and Portuguese:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts, a candidate shall have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors of the University in the subject for which admission is sought or an examination of any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

B] DD Kosambi School of Social Sciences & Behavioural Studies:

i) Master of Arts in Sociology, Geography, Wellness Counselling and Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance and Counselling:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts a candidate shall have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognised as equivalent thereto.

ii) Master of Social Work:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Social Studies a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

iii) Master of Arts in Women's Studies:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Women's Studies, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

C] Goa of Business School:

i) Masters of Commerce (M. Com):

To be eligible for admission to the programme leading to the Degree of Master of Commerce (M.Com.), a candidate must have passed the examination for the Degree of B. Com/BBA/BBA(FS), of this University or an examination of any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

ii) Master of Library and Information Science (M.L.I.Sc):

Graduates in any discipline of the University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto shall be eligible to apply for admission. A student exiting the M.L.I.Sc. Programme after successfully completing one year (40 Credits) shall be awarded B.L.I.Sc. Degree. A student who have completed the B.L.I.Sc. shall be offered admission for Semester III of M.L.I.Sc. programme.

iii) M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence

To be eligible for admission to the two-year M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence Programmes, a candidate must have:

i. Bachelor Degree in Computer Science/ Computer Applications/ Data Science/ Artificial

Intelligence/ Engineering (Computer Science/ Information Technology/ Data Science/ AI) or equivalent Degree with at least 55% marks.

ΩR

ii. Bachelor Degree in Mathematics/Statistics/Electronics/Physics/Chemistry/Life Science discipline with at least 55% marks and must have opted for Mathematics at XII Science. Such candidates shall be provisionally admitted until successful completion of Bridge Courses.

OR

Any Bachelor Degree in Engineering (except Computer Science/Information Technology/ Data Science/ AI) with at least 55% marks. Such candidates shall be provisionally admitted until successful completion of Bridge Courses.

Candidates shall have to complete Bridge Courses via self-study. Candidates are advised to undergo the Bridge courses before the start of the programme.

iii. 5% relaxation in minimum percentage of qualifying examination for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/PwD shall be applicable as per State Government Rules.

D] School of Physical and Applied Sciences:

i) Master of Science in Mathematics and Physics:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Mathematics and Physics, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

E] School of Biological Sciences & Biotechnology:

i) Master of Science in Microbiology and Botany:

To be eligible for admission to Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Botany, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in the subject for which admission is sought of the University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

ii) Master of Science in Food Technology:

B.Sc. in Food Technology/ Food Nutrition, and Dietetics/ Microbiology/ Biotechnology/ Zoology/ Chemistry/ Botany/ Life Sciences/ Bio-Sciences or Allied Subjects.

iii) Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Genetics and Medical Laboratory Techniques (PGDCGMLT)

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Diploma in Clinical Genetics and Medical Laboratory Techniques must have passed the examination of degree of Bachelor of Science of this University or from any other recognized University, with at least 32 credits in the first, second and third years taken together under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in the subject of either Zoology, Microbiology, Biotechnology, Chemistry/Biochemistry. In Semester system of examination, the number of papers or units shall be 14, with a total of 1400 marks, out of which eight papers are studies in F.Y. and S.Y. taken together and minimum 6 papers in T.Y. for being eligible for PG admission in that subject.

F] School of Chemical Sciences:

i) Master of Science in Chemistry:

a) To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science

in Chemistry, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science of the University General/ Honors or from any other recognized University, in the subject for which admission is sought.

- b) Candidates applying for admission to the M.Sc. Programme in Chemistry shall be eligible to be admitted to only one of the various specializations at M.Sc., Part II, as notified in the University Prospectus.
- c) Allotment of seats under various specializations of the Master's Programme in Chemistry, shall be specified in the University Prospectus.

ii) Master of Science in Biochemistry:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Biochemistry, a candidate shall have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of this University or from any other recognized University. in Chemistry / BiologicalSciences (Botany, Zoology/ Microbiology/ Biochemistry/ Biotechnology and allied subjects.

G] School of Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Sciences:

i) Master of Science in Applied Geology:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Applied Geology, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of the University or from any other recognized University, in the subject for which admission is sought.

ii) Master of Science in Marine Science:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Marine Science Programme, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science of the University or from any other recognized University, in Mathematics/Physics/Chemistry/Biology/Hydrochemistry/EnvironmentalScience/Environmental Chemistry/ Marine Science/Ocean Science/Biotechnology. A candidate with BSc Geography /B.C.A with mathematics at HSSC level is also eligible.

iii) Master of Science in Marine Microbiology:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Marine Microbiology, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors in Microbiology/ Biotechnology of the University or from any other recognized University.

iv) Master of Science in Environmental Science

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Environmental Science, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors of the University or from any other University.

v) Master of Science in Remote Sensing & GIS:

To be eligible for admission to a Programme leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Remote Sensing & GIS, a candidate must have passed the examination of the Degree of Bachelor of Science General/ Honors/ B.E. in any branch of the University or from any other University

H] School of International and Area Studies:

(i) MA International Studies:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in International Studies, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

I] Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance & Public Policy:

(i) Master of Arts in Public Administration:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Public Administration, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

(ii) Master of Laws:

To be eligible for admission to Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Laws, a candidate must have completed graduation in Law from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

J] School of Sanskrit, Philosophy and Indic Studies:

(i) Master of Arts in Philosophy:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Philosophy, a candidate must have passed the examination of Degree of Bachelor of Arts General/ Honors in the subject of Philosophy from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

(ii) Master of Arts in Sanskrit Studies:

To be eligible for admission to the Programmes leading to the Degree of Master of Arts in Sanskrit Studies, a candidate must have completed graduation in any discipline from this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto.

RULES FOR SELECTION

RANK LISTS FOR ALL PROGRAMMES SHALL BE NOTIFIED ON THE UNIVERSITY WEBSITE.

Selection of Candidates for Programmes which are offered at a single location

Selected Candidates shall be offered admission on a provisional basis and shall have to pay the Seat Confirmation Fee of INR.10,000/- on Samarth portal. The last date for the payment of Seat Confirmation Fee shall be notified.

A. Selection of Candidates for Programmes which are offered at multiple locations/Institutions.

For Programmes offered at both the University as well as the affiliated colleges or at multiple colleges, seats shall be allotted through PHYSICAL COUNSELLING which shall be held at the Goa University Campus.

The Institution selected at the time of filling the Samarth Registration form shall not be considered as final preference. The institute shall be allotted as per the availability of seats in the concerned institute at the time of Physical Counselling. The candidates must attend the counselling to be eligible for allotment of seats. No seats shall be allotted to the candidates who remain absent during the time of Counselling.

Programmes offered at both the University as well as the affiliated colleges.

REFUND OF FEES

a) If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which s/he is enrolled, the following five tier system shall be followed for the refund of fees remitted by her/him.

- b) In case of (1) in the table above, 5% of the aggregate fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- shall be deducted as processing charges from the refundable amount.
- c) All other cases of refund of fees will be decided on a case-to-case basis on its merit.
- d) The Seat Confirmation Fee is fully refundable in case of withdrawal of provisional admission within 30 days from the last date of admission.
- e) Fees shall be fully refundable in case a candidate fails to qualify the UG Examination.

Anti-ragging Guidelines

In order to curb the bad practices such as ragging on the University campus and in its affiliated colleges, the University authorities are committed to strictly take serious actions on the matter as supported by the law and follow UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menaceof Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009

(https://www.ugc.gov.in/Bureaus/bureaus_details?EwV4Rtmy2xJ7nuhP3MYqbpwm5MTBRSa5u2ipRd_ltuUxMTUu1gSiipessUFP0rnrG) as well as Goa Prohibition of Ragging Act, 2008 and the amendments carried out thereafter.

All concerned must know what constitutes 'ragging'. Any or in multiples of the following acts constitutes ragging:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating inthe discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher.

Following functionaries are in place with defined responsibilities:

ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

- Ensure the compliance of provisions pertaining to UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging as well as the provision of the Goa Prohibition of Ragging Act 2008 (and amendments)
- Monitor, oversee and guide the anti-ragging squad

ANTI RAGGING SQUAD

- Make surprise raids on hostels, other hot-spots to inspect places of potential ragging on the campus
- Conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred by any person and submit an enquiry report along with recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action under clause (a) 9.1 of UGC Regulations on curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and other relevant Rules/State Acts in force.

MONITORING CELL

Co-ordinate with the affiliated Colleges and institutions to curb the menace of ragging

- Invite reports from the heads of the educational institutions in regard to the activities of the functionaries at their end,
- o Conduct orientation programmes, counselling sessions, the incidents of ragging, the problems faced by the wardens or other officials.
- o Keep abreast of the decisions of the District level Anti Ragging Committee.
- Review the efforts made by the institutions to publicize anti-ragging measures, soliciting undertakings from parents and students for each academic year to abstain from ragging activities or willingness to be penalized for violations
- o Function as the prime mover for initiating action on the part of the appropriate authorities of the Goa University for amending its Statutes or Ordinances or Bye-laws as the case may be and to facilitate the implementation of Anti-Ragging measures at the level of the institutions
- Send the status reports periodically to the state level monitoring cell at the frequencies laid down with the support on logistics and smooth functioning from the <u>Directorate of</u> Students Welfare.

As a part of UGC's initiative towards reduction compliance burden of its stakeholders, UGC has revised the procedure for students to file online Anti Ragging Affidavit. The revised procedure is as follows:

Step 1: A student will submit his/her details on the same website (www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org) as before; read and confirm that he/she and his/her parents/Guardians have read and understood the AICTE regulations on curding the menace of ragging. He/She will confirm & agree that he/she will not engage in ragging in any form. (Step is the same like before)

Step 2: The students will receive an e-mail with his/her registration number and a web link. The student will forward the link to the e-mail of the Nodal in his/her University/College. (Please note the student will not receive pdf affidavits and he/she is not required to print & sign it as used to be case earlier)

Step 3: The Nodal Officer in the University/College can click on the link of any forwarded e- mails that he/she will receive from any student of his/her college to get the list of those students who have submitted Anti Ragging Affidavits/Undertaking in his/her college. The list will be updated every 24 hours.

It may be noted that it is compulsory for each student and his/her parent/Guardian to submit an online undertaking each academic year of the two designated websites, namely, www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org.
